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Subtle Energy Training for the Whole Human Being

Thank you for your interest in Integrative Chakra Therapy® (ICT), formerly known as Spiritual Healers' Training for the Whole Human Being! ICT is taught in both Canada: Northern Light News Inc. and the U.S.A. Light News Institute Inc. referred to as "Light News". This is an 18-Level healing course and a journey that blends philosophy, techniques and experiential Chakra Balancing and Spiritual Energy Medicine Healing into a beautiful unfolding of your own awareness.

The basic format of each weekend workshop is the same:

- 10:00 a.m. 5:30 p.m.
- Syllabus of each level with Outline, Topic, Discussion and Exercises.
- Two hours or more of lecture with PowerPoint presentation, plus questions and answers, all recorded live for every student.
- Break for Lunch. (one hour)

 Afternoon experiential healing work with fellow students, starting with Level One. After Level 6, you may invite outside individuals to experience Chakra Energy Work/Healing in the afternoons

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Premise: This course is not just for those who wish to learn Chakra Balancing and Spiritual Healing, but for those who wish to continue their personal spiritual development. You are learning Chakra Balancing and Spiritual Energy Medicine Healing which will include and enhance your pranic, radiatory, telepathic and magnetic healing abilities naturally. ICT is not limited to time or space, because students are working at the level of the chakras where the whole human being emanates his/her individuation into this dimension. Therefore, this is the most powerful and fundamental healing that I know of because it works on the level of consciousness and affects the four archetypes: mental, physical, emotional and spiritual.

Students are taught how to use their chakras to observe the "Whole Human Being" (mental, physical, emotional and spiritual aspects of the individual), to make assessments and to allow healing energy to flow through them. As the students use their chakras, they become stronger, stimulated and eventually awakened. Students learn more than the philosophy and techniques of this powerful healing and undergo their own inner transformation. As students apply healing, balance and support to others, the work helps to heal, balance, and support their own physical, mental, emotional and spiritual development.

Course instruction includes reference to the latest studies on Biofield Science, Energy Medicine and Energy Psychology, Quantum Physics and Toroidal Energy Fields.

The Goal of Integrative Chakra Therapy® for the Whole Human Being is to help you become a self-empowered, selfrealized individual; a spiritually aware independent thinker; emancipated from the illusion of separation from the Oneness in which we live.

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This training will awaken and strengthen your higher sense perceptions as well as your healing abilities and as a result some of your "stuff" will inevitably come up. These levels will cause fundamental core-shifts to happen within you as you infuse more of your **Soul-Quality** into your waking consciousness. Some levels may be challenging to assimilate and take time to integrate, so listening to your lecture recordings and engaging in frequent practicum is helpful for the process. Practicing with fellow students is a **required** component and essential to integrate the levels taught as a base for Dr. Jelusich's more evolved teachings.

Integrative Chakra Therapy® is not for everyone, but is for those who truly desire to become spiritually stronger, more grounded, and for effective facilitation of healing in themselves and others. This course teaches philosophy, science, cosmology and the esoterics of human evolution of consciousness, while providing intellectual and scientific balance to the experiential spiritual training you will do at each level. All healing boils down to one thing only:

Taking the levels: In order to obtain a Certificate of Completion, you must complete all 18 levels of the Integrative Chakra Therapy® training. Some levels may be audited by special permission and interview with the Instructor.

Each student must attend a minimum of three **Practice Sessions** per month (9 hours) to be recorded in their Practice Log. Each session must be under the guidance of your instructor, a Qualified Graduate or Student Teacher as selected by your instructor or Dr. Jelusich. These practice sessions include discussions of class information and How To's to improve your techniques and skills.



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Each student must complete the **Reflective Practice Assignments** for each level of training and deliver to the Instructor via email, drop-box or regular post prior to the next level of training. Note: every practice session provides opportunity for questions to be answered regarding these reports and a practice session is ideal for writing the assignments.

There are two Integrative Chakra Therapy® levels taught in each training weekend; with the exception of Level 3 and Level 18 which each require a full weekend for training. Some levels are about the philosophy of healing and some are about techniques. Dr. Jelusich (currently lead faculty and Chair of the Board of Directors at the California Institute for Human Science) has included the teaching of some science in the course, aiding students to be current with both esoteric and practical applications of Chakra Balancing and Spiritual Energy Medicine Healing and its effects.

Integrative Chakra Therapy® (ICT) Students are taught two important phases of healing work:

- 1. **The Healing Work itself** Students are taught what Subtle Energy, Chakra Balancing and Spiritual Energy Medicine Healing really are, how they work, how to use them, how to create a safe environment, and how to use their own chakras to view the character of the person they are working with.
- 2. **The Story** Students are taught how to interpret their intuitive impressions when working with clients in order to *tell* the story of what the healing is, what caused the problem in the first place, and what to do about it. Students are encouraged to continue to develop their abilities to deeply understand the healing power that is flowing through them, and to be able to articulate the exact mental, physical, spiritual and emotional condition of the client.

"While you are working with someone, your instructor is working energetically/ spiritually with you, making adjustments to your chakras, energy field, grounding, etc. Much energy is being moved in these workshops, and it is expected that students will have unique experiences and reactions while learning healing techniques.

Your instructor creates a safe and loving atmosphere for the work and their students. Students learn in an experiential, hands-on environment. Workshops are taught and recorded with a topic lecture on methods, techniques and philosophy followed by hands-on or hands-off active healing practice under your instructor's direct supervision."

Students-in-training learn about their true multidimensional nature and philosophy of one-ness.

It is strongly suggested that students take it easy and rest after each level. Most people and many students do not understand energy work, so they can get tired and some of their "stuff" can come up after a weekend of training. This is normal. Many students are now *taking Monday off* after the weekend training. It is good to get rest in the day following classes in order to process the integration of what you have learned and experienced.

These teachings can bring up some of the students' "stuff" simply because the students are now using, awakening and developing strength in their chakras while observing the condition of others' mental, physical, emotional, and spiritual states. While developing themselves spiritually, students are presented with their own issues and karma (along with their increased abilities to deal with releasing their karma) much faster.

Your greatest success is achieved when you trust with your heart first, then use your mind.





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Daily Format of Training Levels:

- 9:00-9:50 a.m. Signing in required for each training level
 - Collect the syllabus for that day's training level.
 - A binder is supplied for storing your syllabi and other materials with the registration of your first weekend (Level 3). The syllabus for each level covers the main points and exercises, and a list of recommended readings.

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- If you have not pre-paid, payment is due and will be accepted Saturday morning from 9-9:45 a.m.
- 10 a.m. ICT Training begins and is completed around 5:30 p.m. (occasionally later).
- A Guided Meditation begins each day's workshop, promptly at 10 a.m. Note: Doors are closed for Meditation
- **Lecture:** Two hours or more of lecture follows the meditation with a PowerPoint presentation. Files will either be placed on your personal flash drive or sent via DropBox or MP3 files end of day, Sunday. NOTE: All your questions and answers are recorded live for students to review.
- Break for lunch: Students may bring a lunch or dine out as time permits (usually 60-90 minutes).
- 2:00/ 2:30 p.m. Experiential Healing: Even at Level 1, you will be up and doing healing work. Your Instructor will be working (making energetic adjustments) on all the healers as they work on the people on the tables.
 - o Most students highly underestimate subtle energy healing, so please get adequate rest, drink water, and follow your own spiritual practices after healing workshops. If possible take Monday off to rest.
 - Levels 1-5 you practice with your fellow healers. After Level 6, you are encouraged to invite people to come for a healing experience. Students will do the experiential healing (practicum) and then discuss the healing work with the volunteer after each round of healing. There are usually 3 to 4, 15-minute rounds per afternoon.
- End of Class: The recording of your classes will be sent to you via Dropbox. Your instructor covers some deeply esoteric teachings that you can absorb more fully over time by listening to them again quietly at your leisure.
- Massage Tables. We use massage tables for the comfort of the person being worked on. The rule of thumb is one massage table for every four students (one person on the table, 3 or 4 healers). It would be helpful if you have a massage table and could bring it. Please call or email and let us know, so we can coordinate having enough tables.

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Registration is Required

- Registration materials and instructions are on pages 8-10 of this packet.
- Prerequisite 'Introduction to Integrative Chakra Therapy' Levels 1 & 2 offered throughout the year in various locations.



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- For the remaining Levels 3 19: Each student must have completed the following:
- 1. Application/Registration Form (see page 7)
- 2. Brief essay about your spiritual beliefs and reasons for taking the program.
- 3. Resume Including: information on your (1) Education, (2) Profession, and (3) Spiritual training or Beliefs.
- Students can take Module 1: Levels 1 3, and have a grounded understanding of the Human Biofield and Chakras
- Students can take Module 2: Levels 4 9, and will have a solid understanding of Energy Medicine using Chakras and the Human Biofield (May be taken within two years of levels 1 -3 without reviewing the first 3 levels)
- Students completing Modules 3 & 4: Levels 10-18, will have a solid understanding and awareness of the character of the "human spiritual nature" and a grounded understanding of the science of metaphysics.
- Advanced Training Modules include; Level 19: Transitions where students learn how to work with souls transitioning from this incarnation, and their remaining loved ones; Teacher Training, where students apprentice and learn to become an instructor of Integrative Chakra Therapy® and become certified to teach the course.

The Two Paths to Graduation:

- Non-Certified "Certificate of Completion" Those who do not wish to be certified practitioners and have completed levels 9 - 18 will receive a certificate of completion and will understand all aspects of Dr. Jelusich's Integrative Chakra Therapy® course to implement in daily life. * Although practice logs and reflective practice assignments are not required for a certificate of completion it is highly recommended that students participate in writing and recording these logs as it will help you greatly in your growth and awareness throughout the course.
- Certified "Certified ICT Practitioner" Those who wish to use the course in a clinical setting will have completed reflective practice logs, practicum, tests and assignments. These logs and assignments are to be delivered to Dr. Jelusich or your ICT instructor for review. Upon completing the requirements for certification, you will receive a certificate as an ICT Practitioner.
 - Should a student drop out of ICT and wish to return, they can do so if they have not been away from the course for more than 1 yr. and must provide proof of practice. Upon the discretion of the instructor, students may be asked to audit the classes they have already taken.

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Non-refundable Registration Processing Fee: of \$100 US (\$100 CAD plus GST). Once registration has been received, Light News will ship the required reading materials: *Eye of the Lotus* and *I Can Relate* along with confirmed acceptance to the program. If you already own these two books a credit of \$50.00 will be placed on file for your first training weekend.

- Should a student register for the class and prepay and the class be canceled by Light News all funds less the registration fee of \$100 will be refunded within 30 days of Light News cancellation date. In this case a student's registration can be carried forward to the next available course offered by that instructor.
- All prepayments are non-refundable but may be transferred to another student or new student joining the program with exception to above.

Payment Options: for the FULL Two and one-half year 18 Level Course (10 weekends)

Total Course Cost of \$5,000.00 in US or Canada. Note: GST will be added to all Canadian courses.

In Canada:

- 1. 10 Weekend Payments of \$525.00, (including GST) due to be paid at the beginning of each training weekend.
- 2. Pay for your total course up front and receive a 15% discount: \$4,462.50 (including GST)
- **3.** Monthly Payments of \$230.00 x 24 months which includes gst and monthly admin processing fee. *Post-dated checks/cheques must be received before or on the first day of class. Other preferred methods of payment must be discussed with instructor to be agreed upon on an individual basis.*

Please arrive early: to either pay or to just get yourself settled, we ask you to give yourself time to be settled in and ready for the morning meditation which begins promptly at 10 a.m.

Payments Accepted: Cash, Check/Cheque, E-transfer, VISA/MC via Square (No Debit), PayPal



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Graduation Requirements: Graduation in the Integrative Chakra Therapy® program requires all students to finish each of the 18 levels, including attending and participating in group practice sessions in both the classroom environment and with qualified Instructors, Graduates or Teachers-in-Training outside of the classroom. In addition, there are a minimum of 90 written case study assignments (reflective practices assignments) to this training; 10 of which **must be completed** following **each** weekend of training. That is, five for each level of training and returned to your instructor prior to the next level of training. Note: Special instructions for Level 3 (10 assignments); Level 16 (only if a Soul Infusion is performed) and Level 18 (no assignment).

Student Practice and Reflective Study Assignments:

- 1. Reflective practice assignments are part of the ICT program. To graduate and receive documents stating you are a *Certified Integrative Chakra Therapy® Practitioner* a minimum of 10 Reflective Practice Assignments must be submitted, in between each course level. Additionally, signed Practice Logs of hours practiced must accompany the assignments. please be certain to review your assignments and take notes of questions and concerns.
- 2. Those who wish to take the course for personal development and not submit Reflective Practice Assignments will receive a *Certificate of Completion* and will not be a Certified ICT Practitioner.

Exams and Written Documentation: Written and/or Oral Examinations will be delivered in class at various levels of study to guide the course direction and to supplement the teachings. All exams are either take-home or in-class and reviewed during class time. A written assignment may be given to those wishing to be Certified upon the discretion of the instructor.

Evaluations: Your instructor may make energetic adjustments during each level to support development of your natural abilities in a balanced manner. After level 7 of the training, your instructor will give evaluations to all students regarding their progress, strengths and weaknesses. This is essential feedback that assists students with choices (ideas/actions) to continue strengthening and *developing their abilities in healthy balance*. These evaluations partly reflect your participation in class; including all exams (quizzes) which may be delivered throughout the course.

Practice is imperative between levels; a practice log of a **minimum of 10 practice sessions** (between course weekends) is also required to be handed in prior to each level of training. Each student is evaluated on his/her class participation and performance by their instructor and will only graduate based on a committed level of attendance and participation in class including all; lectures, assignments and practices.

Practice, practice! Practice with other students is **essential** to your training. Listening to your audio file recordings increases your connection to the energetic presence of the teachings. Ask questions, apply what you've learned.

Dharma Hours: Each student wishing to receive Certification must complete a minimum of **80 Dharma Hours** to complete the course. Dharma Hours are supervised volunteer hours at conferences, trade shows, public events where the student is interacting with the general public discussing the tools and techniques of Integrative Chakra Therapy®, or contributions to the promotion and advancement of Light News Institute in some way agreed upon with your instructor. A hosted information night with practice is considered a Dharma event and counts towards Dharma hours – although regular practice hours, such as Student Clinic for Public, are **not** a part of the Dharma hours or events.

Continuing Education Credits (CEU): The Integrative Chakra Therapy® course taught by Dr. Jelusich is not yet part of the U.S. or Canadian educational system. *Currently Light News Institute Inc. is working on CEU certification of the program for the U.S. and Canada, to provide students a way of being recognized to obtain CEUs for massage therapists, nurses, acupuncturists, and hypnotherapists. In the U.S., the program currently qualifies for 4 units of independent study with the California Institute for Human Science. The program also provides one year of course study for students wishing to follow the Spiritualist Ministry path through Universal Church of the Master, San Jose, CA.

Attendance Requirements:

- Due to course content, beyond levels 1 and 2, Dr. Jelusich is reluctant to teach or allow 'Make-up' classes. The class calendar is prepared well in advance to allow sufficient time to resolve scheduling issues. The synergy of the group experiential practice is a very powerful and important part of all Healers' Training Levels. That synergy is called "The Maharishi Effect".
- If a student cannot attend a Training level, he/she may:
 - Travel to another city (or join online if available) to take the level(s) missed classes are currently offered in Calgary, Alberta; Nanaimo, BC in Canada; San Diego, California in U.S.
 - Schedule a Make-up at the Instructor's discretion.
 - Speak with their instructor regarding any conflict of dates and possible solutions.
 - Miss graduating with their HT class. (In special circumstances and with instructor's approval, it may be possible to take a short leave of absence from the Training and return joining a subsequent group.)
